- Children need a support system.

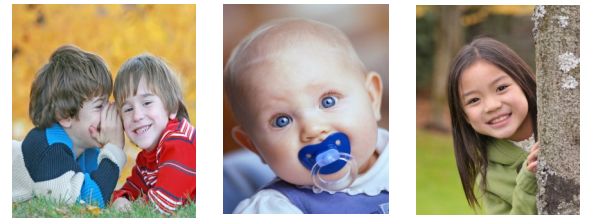
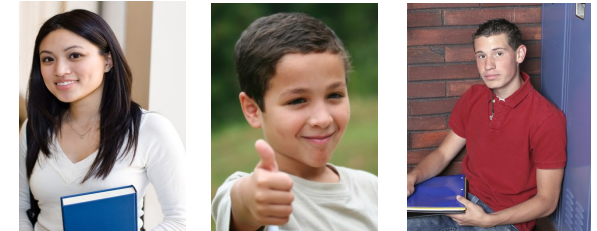
